

## aw2.template

We use template to differentiate the block of code. We can use it again and again so it will avoid redundancy of code.

```
[aw2.template box]
[/aw2.template]
```

To run this template you have to write a statement:

```
[aw2.run templates.box /]
```

When we want to add nested conditions or loops, template helps you to implement the code.

[aw2.template check_post]
  [aw2.do cond="{module.gallery_results}" less_than="1"]
    <section role="error" class="container">
      <h3 class="alert alert-warning col-md-12" role="alert">Please add some Gallery <a href="[aw2.get function.site_url]/wp-admin/edit.php?post_type=asf_gallery">Click to add Gallery</a></h3>
    </section>

```
[aw2.do logged_in=true]
  [aw2.if user_can="administrator"]
    [aw2.run templates.check_post /]
  [/aw2.if]
[/aw2.do]
```

- If you want to make template global you have to trigger it as init hook by using `global=true` while writing template.

```
[aw2.template template_name global=true]
